In addition to the exhibition of the works of at least 23 artists from across the nation and around the world, a 3-day celebration of World Down Syndrome Day will include a film festival, panels of siblings, self advocates, a symposium on the progress of DS cognitive research, and a concert by Chris Burke and his band.
